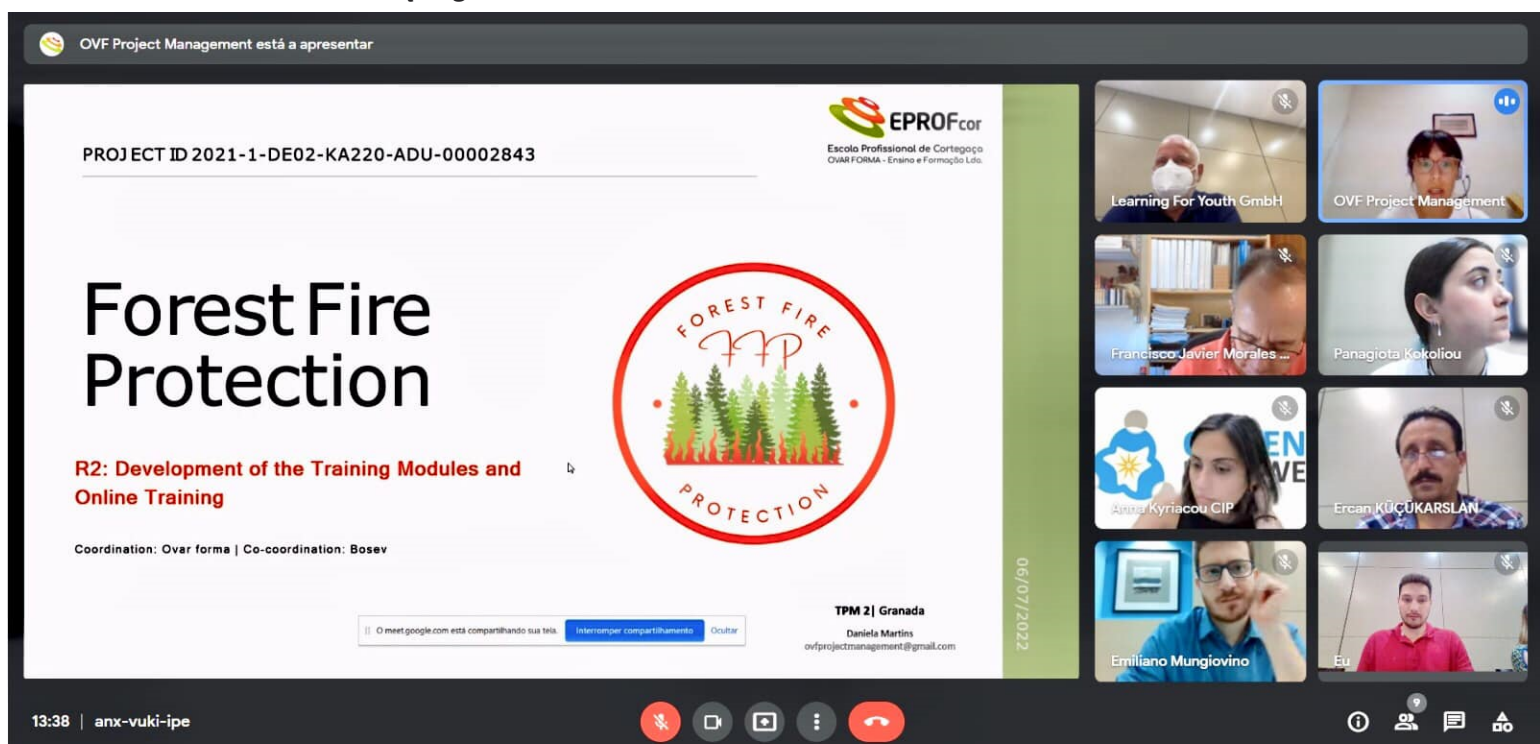

# The partners held the second Project meeting on 6 and 7 July, where Growthcoop hosted the project meeting in Granada, Spain.

## R1 – Training Framework current and forthcoming activities

The partnership interviewed almost 200 people to collect data on good practices and data on forest fire prevention and protection. This data has been validated by 27 experts in forest fire and enabled the creation of a training structure for a module on "Forest fire prevention and self-protection against forest fire" that will be developed in Result 2. A report with the main findings of R1 will be made public on the project's website soon.



R2 will be devoted to the elaboration of the training module and an online platform. The information so far gathered and validated by the experts has convinced the partnership that the training module will support the transfer of knowledge and skills to the rural populations to increase their safety, thereby matching the objectives of the project.

## Dissemination activities

In parallel with Result 1 and Result 2, the partnership is engaging in dissemination activities in order to create interest from relevant stakeholders. This is especially important since, in a further phase of the project, the partnership will pilot test the training module in rural communities.

## The great importance of this project

This summer's forest fires in Europe not only mean hectares burned, lives lost and homes destroyed, they are a further boost to global warming, which in turn makes fires more intense and more common. Fires have caused the highest greenhouse gas emissions since 2007. All this underlines the great importance of the objectives of the FFP project.

Especially the importance of training the population of rural areas and neighboring regions on how to act in case of fire, fire prevention, actions to increase resistance to forest fires in rural areas and to increase the safety of populations
