### Completed Results



#### Result #1:

A training framework for a module named "<u>Fire Prevention and Self-</u> <u>Protection Against Forest Fires</u>". It contains the topics that should be included in training resources related to Forest Fire prevention, as validated by experts from the area.

#### Result #2

A module has been developed according to the training framework from #1, with three different units.

To complement, other resources and trainers guidelines are being developed. Once completed, the content will be made public as Open Education Resources (OER) for every community to use.

### Rural Road Trips

The partners of the FFP project are currently organizing rural road trips and online sessions aimed at engaging stakeholders from rural communities. The main objective of these sessions is to disseminate the training content developed and the aims of the project.

The stakeholders who will be encouraged to disseminate the material in order to enhance awareness and preparedness of their populations in areas that are susceptible to forest fires.

Finally, the partnership intends to implement training programs to some of the locations where the stakeholders are based in the period that preceds the fire season in Europe.
